

Otters hold hands and float while they're sleeping!

What do you do when you have to sleep but you spend all your time in the ocean? You hold hands! This behavior is called "rafting," and otters do it so they don't drift away from the group while resting. Otters have the thickest fur of any mammal and this helps them float. Sometimes they also anchor together by wrapping themselves in seaweed. Scientists have counted over a 1000 otters in one raft.

MYSTERIOUS LAKE



We think of lakes as being old, carved by moving glaciers or created by ancient asteroids. But every now and then, a new lake just pops up. In 2014, desert shepherds in Gafsa, Tunisia discovered that a lake had formed, virtually overnight (pictured above). Some called it a miracle, particularly since it happened in the desert. The most likely explanation is that a small earthquake opened an underground spring that filled the lake.

MYTHICAL SEA MONSTERS

The ocean is vast and deep. Who knows what might swim under the surface?



The **LEVIATHAN** is mentioned six times in the Bible's Old Testament. The beast is often described as a sea serpent that can breathe fire, a swimming dragon.

The **ASPIDOCELEON** is mentioned in early Christian texts as a giant turtle or whale that has a whole beach on its back. It lures sailors to dock their boats on its beach and then drowns them when it submerges.





A **KRAKEN** is the legendary creature said to inhabit the waters between Iceland and Norway. Often depicted as a giant octopus, it is said to drag down ships.

A **UMIBOZU** from Japanese tradition is a giant, shadowy, human figure who appears to sailors during calm waters which quickly become stormy. If you see one, expect your ship to sink.





From Greek tradition, the **CHARYBDIS** was a sea monster that would create a whirlpool when it opened its mouth. Odysseus and Jason and the Argonauts all had to battle Charybdis.


But why? The legend of Atlantis is fiction. In fact, we know who first wrote it and when.

MER - WHAT?


